English:

- Develop reading comprehension skills
- Guided/group reading
- Read a variety of fiction and non-fiction texts
- Read and write Traditional Tales and Myths

- Develop story writing skills by creating our own characters and plots based on myths we have read
- Handwriting using cursive script
- Develop our non-fiction writing through explanations, instructions and reports

Maths:

- Read and write numbers to 100 in numerals and words
- Multiplication and division facts for the 2x, 5x and 10x tables
- Addition and subtraction with renaming
- Mentally add/subtract 2 digit numbers
- Solve word problems involving addition/subtraction and multiplication/division
- Find totals of money and give change
- Identify fractions of shapes and quantities e.g. $\frac{1}{3}$, $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{3}{4}$
- Recall doubles and halves to 20
- Estimate and measure length, mass, temperature, volume and capacity
- Describe properties of 2D and 3D shapes
- Tell the time to five minute intervals
- Interpret and construct pictograms, tally charts, block charts and tables

Science:

Living things and their habitats

- Basic needs of humans and animals for survival
- The importance of exercise, a balanced diet and hygiene for humans

P.S.H.E.:

- Rules for the school environment
- Road safety
- Personal hygiene
