Dear Parents,

As part of our Year 5 topic on World War II, we have organised a trip to Thorndon Country Park to step back in time to glimpse life as a World War II soldier. The children will explore the wartime sites and take part in training exercises. They will have the opportunity to experiment with different types of shelter and camouflage, act out wartime roles, rig up stretchers and race against the clock to save their comrades!
