

### Read, Write, Inc phonics

At school we follow the scheme RWI to teach phonics. This is a great way to teach the children the sounds in preparation for learning to read. The children will progress through the scheme from learning set 1 to set 3 speed sounds. We have included some links for parent tutorials to learn all about how to support your child as they learn with *Read Write Inc. Phonics*, with detailed ideas and advice on pronouncing pure sounds, blending, and digraphs. It is really important to say the sounds clearly to help your child learn them. We say 'mmmm' not 'muh' and 'lllll' not 'luh' when teaching the sounds. This really helps children when they learn to blend sounds together to read words.
