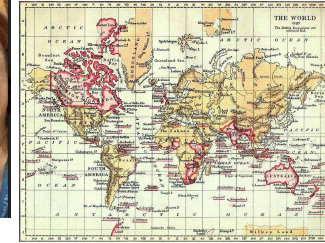


# LOLOL - School Learning
